Anything needed urgently will be provided. Some of the below "Essential Kits" will be available to buy at the start of the course.

ESSENTIAL

You **MUST** have a pair of steel toe safety shoes and some old clothes / overalls suitable to workshop wear and painting.

These are needed from day 1 and are not provided by the College.

You will NOT be allowed into the Design workshops without safety shoes.

A kit containing all these items is available for £80 (half retail price).

This is a good starting kit for all students studying design for Performance on Set Design, Puppetry & Scenic Art & Construction Costume (design & construction – please note the *items, would not be necessary for those studying costume), pathways.
