**MA Design for Performance** students are advised to wait until they arrive on the first day of term and we can have a discussion about what they need for their selected pathway. Anything needed urgently will be provided. Some of the below "Essential Kits" will be available to buy at the start of the course.

### **ESSENTIAL**

You **MUST** have a pair of steel toe safety shoes and some old clothes / overalls suitable to workshop wear and painting.

These are needed from day 1 and are not provided by the College.

You will NOT be allowed into the Design workshops without safety shoes.

Having a laptop or tablet to support your design and academic studies is a crucial part of your learning.
